

# Easter Pop-up Card

## What You Need

- Pattern for an Easter symbol
- 8 1/2" x 11" colored construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Felt-tipped markers

## What You Do

1. Have the children choose and trace an Easter symbol. When they have outlined the pattern, show them how to add a tab to each side (see below).
2. Children can decorate their symbol with markers.
3. When they are done, children can fold the symbol in half horizontally, crease the fold, and open it out again. They should also fold back the tabs.
4. Tell children to fold the construction paper in half to make a card.
5. Children then put glue on the tabs and place the cut-out symbol so that its folded line is exactly on top of the middle fold of the card.
6. Show children how to close the card with the symbols folded inside, and press until the glue is dry.
7. On the outside, children can print an Easter message and decorate with markers.
8. When the card is dry, children can open it and the Easter symbol will pop up.
