

## Oberlin Road Waterline Improvements Construction Update

The City's contractor is making good progress with the waterline replacement project on Oberlin Road. Currently, the Wade Avenue westbound (WB) ramps off Oberlin Road are planned to be reopened on Wednesday, October 20<sup>th</sup>.

As planned with the opening of the Wade Avenue WB ramps, the Oberlin Road closure will be extended south to Wade Avenue from Craig Street also beginning on Wednesday, October 20<sup>th</sup>. The road closure is scheduled for approximately three months. Detours will be in place and access will be maintained for local traffic only. The revised detour will utilize Wade Avenue, St. Mary's Street and Fairview Road to access Oberlin Road.

The City's contractor will have two crews working on Oberlin Road to help meet the schedule outlined above. Please be aware of all posted traffic signs, detours, traffic cones, and work crews.
